



Choice of Safety Pen Needles and Lancets

Lancashire and South Cumbria ICB recommends the use of safety needles costing less than £13 per 100 needles and safety lancets costing less than £6 per 100, only in exceptional circumstances and where clinically appropriate. Providing safety needles does not replace the provision of education and training on correct use, and safe disposal of sharps. All the safety needles below utilise a passive mechanism for activating the safety features i.e. the safety feature locks automatically after injection to prevent accidental needle stick injuries. The safety needle with the lowest acquisition cost should be the preferred choice where possible, such as Apollo Pro-Shield Safety 4mm/30g. Speak to your ICB medicines optimisation team, if more expensive needles are requested which are above the £13 per 100 cost threshold.
